## 8.\* MOTION (Hon. Leonard Kirui)

THAT, aware that the defunct local authorities compulsorily acquired a piece of Land from the residents of Siongiroi ward under the repealed Land Acquisition Act Cap 295, further aware that Article 40(3)(b) of the Constitution gives power to the state to compulsorily acquire private property for a public purpose or in the public interest and that such acquisition requires that there be prompt payment in full of just compensation to the person; also further aware that the defunct local authorities as a way of compensation resettled the said residents of Siongiroi ward in a village currently referred to as Legetetiet village; deeply concerned that since resettlement, the said residents have not been issued with the title deeds and that such delay has crippled the dealings with the land by the said residents; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to fast-track the issuance of title deeds to those residents of Siongiroi ward.
