5. NOTICE OF MOTION (Hon. Ambrose Koech)

THAT, aware that the County Health Services including promotion of primary health care is one of the devolved functions under part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya, 2010; also aware that one of the main goals of the County Government is to improve preventive health care system within the County; further aware that the County Government currently incur a lot of expenses in treatment of primary infections such as typhoid and other communicable diseases being reported in most public health centres and dispensaries; deeply concerned that most of these diseases are easily preventable thereby saving the county massive resources; this County Assembly urges the County Executive to urgently liaise with Non-Governmental organizations such as UZIMA to facilitate free provision of water filters within the County.
