**4. MOTION (Hon. Marcella Chepkirui)**

**THAT**, aware that Health is a devolved function under fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, further aware that the institutional structure of health negates mechanisms of handling with due care and diligence the victims of sexual abuse and gender based violence. Considering that most crimes of sexual abuse against children, youth and women and other related gender based violence are by people known to the victims, cognizant that availability of a well institutionalized programme in the department of health will be of great significance in addressing the specific cases of sexual abuse and gender based violence, noting that there is a huge burden on the victims of sexual abuse and gender based violence to come forward and report the crime(s) because of the shame that will bring to the family by exposing accused persons who are perpetrators, this County Assembly therefore resolves, that the County Executive Committee Member responsible for Health establishes in each Sub County Hospital, Social Welfare and Protections Units which will address sexual abuse and gender based violence aimed at providing care focused on the sexual violence victims in addressing the biological, psychological and legal concerns.
