5. NOTICES OF MOTION

The following notices of motions were given

- i) That aware that Article 46(a) and (b) of the Constitution of Kenya provides that every person is entitled to goods and services of reasonable quality and to information necessary for them to gain full benefit from goods and services; also aware that section 116 (1) and (2) of the County Governments Act 2012 provides that the County Government and its agencies shall have obligation to deliver services within its designated area of jurisdiction and that the county shall deliver services while observing the principles of equity, efficiency, accessibility, non-discrimination, transparency, accountability, sharing of data

and information and subsidiarity; further aware that section 117(2) (a) of the County Governments Act provides that public services shall be equitably delivered in a manner that accords to prudent, economic, efficient, effective and sustainable use of available resources; also aware that the main purpose of having a service charter is to define the service experience the client will have with the organization and responsibilities of both the organization and the client; Deeply concerned that the Bomet County Executive has no service delivery charter to assist it to provide core services to the public; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to formulate and adopt an elaborate Service Charter to streamline the delivery of services to the Public. **(Hon. Wesley Kiprotich)**

- ii) That aware that economic, efficient and effective use of resources is among the guiding principles of public service provided for under Article 232 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010; also aware that asset management strategies is one of the sound financial management and expenditure control that a county must include in planning; noting with concern that the County Executive vehicles are being utilized for non-official purposes thereby incurring unnecessary costs to the County; deeply concerned that if this habit is not curbed then the County Government will lose substantial amount of money in operation and maintenance which does not in any way related to development; this County Assembly urges the Bomet County Executive Committee to take urgent measures and establish a check unit to monitor and control the use of vehicles owned by the County Government of Bomet.. **(Hon. Wesley Kiprotich)**
- iii) **THAT**, pursuant to section 12 (d) of the County Governments Act 2012, this County Assembly notes the report of the Bomet County Assembly Service Board on the interview for the position of two members of the board who are non-members of the County Assembly laid on the Table of the County Assembly on 9th October, 2018 and approves the recommendation for appointment of **Joel Kipkorir Sigei** as a member of the Bomet County Assembly Service Board representing the male gender **(Hon. Leonard Kirui, Vice Chairperson, Bomet County Assembly Service Board)**.
